3. **Spring Book Fair:** Is March 26-30<sup>th</sup>. The librarian, Mrs. Miles, is chairing the event since it is now a school-sponsored event. Mrs. Devine reported the school has a goal to continue book bucks for the students. She will confirm this later. The book fair will be noted in the March newsletter.
