

**Buckeye Elementary School
PTC Meeting Minutes
October 10, 2006
Buckeye Library**

PTC President Lori Burne called the meeting to order at 3:35 p.m. and introductions were made.

Treasurer's Report

Jill Larner presented the Treasurer's Report for Amanda Templeton. The current balance of PTC funds is \$12,192.36, with a net balance of \$8,482.36 available after all outstanding expenses are paid.

Old/Ongoing Business

1. **BBQ Debrief:** Jill Larner said that after all expenses were paid for the BBQ, there was a net balance of \$396.78 from the event. This was not a fundraising event, so coming out a little ahead was a good thing. Thank you again to Mr. Rust for donating the Kings tickets that raised \$344.
2. **Fundraiser Update:** Will be discussed at November meeting.
3. **Student Store:** Amanda Templeton ordered new stock and the store will start Tues., 10/17. Lori Burne offered to staff the store that day. There will be a sign in the staff room to remind teachers.
4. **Book Fair:** Nikki Costello will prepare a financial report from the previous book fair. PTC has historically provided cash for the registers and handled the bills for the book fair. This may change since the librarian is now organizing the event. PTC agreed to continue providing cash drawers for the event. The proceeds of the book fair can be taken in either cash or book credit. The cash offer is much less in value than the book credit. Buckeye has always taken the proceeds in book credits for the library and in Book Bucks (a free book for each child) at the next event. A motion was made to continue to accept book fair proceeds in book credits. The motion was seconded and approved. Nikki reported each teacher will receive a \$50 book credit from the proceeds of last book fair. This is in addition to the Book Bucks for the kids. The book credits will also be given to the new preschool and the extended day teachers.
5. **100 Club:** Will be discussed at the November meeting.

New Business

1. **Jr. Achievement Program:** Lisa Culver presented the program and is seeking support from parents and teachers at Buckeye. Five classes are currently doing the program in their classrooms. It is a 5-week commitment of 1 hr/week. All lessons and materials are

provided. There is no cost to the school or teachers. Information will be sent to parents in the PTC newsletter and in a separate flyer for Friday Folders.

2. **Red Ribbon Week:** Mrs. Kloczko said that bracelets have been ordered for each child. RRW will overlap with the Book Fair on 10/23-27. Caren Chumbly will provide sample lessons and resources to the teachers. Artwork will be displayed on doors. Parent help is needed for the artwork. A RRW schedule was handed out and is attached to the minutes.
3. **Rock Climbing Wall:** Mr. Rust presented the findings of his research and recommended the purchase of a rock-climbing wall for the MPR. It is a 16 ft long by 8 ft tall vertical wall that comes in 4' panels. It has a safety mat that folds up and locks the wall off when not in use. The wall is disabled accessible. The cost is \$3,200, which includes tax, hardware, mat, and free shipping. Mrs. Devine said that district personnel and parent volunteers would install the wall. Mr. Rust also requested the purchase of more Speed Stack sets because of the popularity with the kids and growing competitions. A motion was made to fund a rock-climbing wall, hardware, mat, etc., and Speed Stack sets in an amount not to exceed \$3,600. The motion was seconded and passed.
4. **Holiday Gift Shop:** Nikki Costello said we would use the same vendor in Rancho Cordova. Products range in cost from \$.25 - \$11. Potential dates for the Gift Shop are Dec. 2, 9th, or 16th. Times are Friday 5-8p.m, and Saturday 8a.m.-1p.m. Boy Scouts will be contacted to see if they want to do another pancake breakfast. The coffee vendor will also be contacted. Mrs. Devine said that two hours custodial time is needed at weekend events.
5. **T-Shirts:** Jill Lerner said there has been interest in ordering more t-shirts and sweatshirts using the same logo (no date) as last year on light gray. A local vendor has offered to do them for one low price, regardless of the amount ordered. The vendor is also willing to provide samples to hang in the office so people can choose the appropriate size before ordering. A volunteer is needed to organize the t-shirt order.
